



## Fifth Ward's low-income housing project shows progress

HOUSTON -- The Houston Housing authority showed the U.S. Secretary for Housing and Urban development the progress Monday at the new and improved affordable housing project in Fifth Ward.

Last December a bulldozer tore through the low-income housing complex, which was in bad need of repair. In the months since, construction crews have been rebuilding Kennedy Place in the 500 block of Bayou just south of Interstate 10 and East of Highway 59.

When Kennedy Place is finished in December the homes will have central heating and air conditioning, individual garages and energy-efficient appliances. More than 100 families be able to move into the complex.

The multi-million dollar renovation project was made possible through federal-stimulus money.
