New Vice President of Fiscal Operations to join Houston Housing Authority as demand for public housing remains strong, funding expected to drop

HOUSTON—A new Vice President of Fiscal Operations will join the Houston Housing Authority this summer as the agency works to address waiting lists for each of its programs while grappling with potential decreases in federal funding.

Lloyd Waguespack, Jr. will join the Housing Authority on July 1. Waguespack currently serves as the Deputy Chief of Staff – Administrative Departments for the City of Houston, where he is responsible for oversight of nine city departments and manages the city’s relationship with the local and regional offices of the federal Housing and Urban Development Department.
